"For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful"

LET'S TALK



You can sit in class, eyes on the board, appearing attentive—yet your mind is miles away. Then the lesson ends, and you suddenly realize you didn't absorb a single thing. Sometimes, that's how people pray. Their spirit is talking to God, but their mind is busy somewhere else. Meanwhile, praying in tongues is one of the most powerful spiritual exercises you can engage in. It's the language of the Spirit through which you utter divine mysteries. When you pray in tongues, your spirit communicates directly with God, bypassing the limitations of the natural mind.

However, your prayer becomes far more impactful and effective when your mind is engaged as you speak in tongues. Just like when you're studying, listening in class, or playing a game, you need to stay focused. Fix your attention on what you're praying about. There may be the tendency for your mind to wander as you pray, maybe thinking about your phone, music, friends, or what you'll do next, but refuse the distractions and deliberately keep your mind focused on the Spirit.

As you do, He'll flood your mind with visions, thoughts, and ideas. These may be revelations from God or creative insights that He inspires within you. He enables you to see possibilities, create godly imaginations, and bring divine realities into manifestation. You may suddenly receive ideas for your schoolwork, your future, or how to help others. As He grants you visions, respond accordingly; that's how you

partner with Him to bring Heaven's plans to pass on earth.

The Christian life is a walk in the Spirit. The Spirit-filled life is a life of rest, joy, and victory. He keeps you strong, refreshed and full of faith, even in school, at home, and among your friends. So, even in prayer, depend on His guidance, follow His instructions, and yield to His influence. Hallelujah!

CREATE GOD-INSPIRED VISIONS

(Your Creative Imagination Is Activated When You Speak In Tongues)

TO THE BIBLE - 1 Corinthians 14:2

"For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries."

LET'S TALK



A skilled architect never begins construction without first seeing the building in his mind. Before the first brick is laid, the vision is clear—every line, every level, every purpose carefully imagined. In the same way, God has designed the human spirit to see before it experiences. When you pray in tongues, you're not merely uttering sounds; you're engaging a divine system for creating realities.

Did you know that you can actually create visions while speaking in tongues? This is one reason you must let the Holy Spirit guide your mind in prayer. There's a difference between a spiritual vision from God that He shows you through your spirit and a spiritual vision that your spirit has the capacity to create. These are two different things.

Many times, we wait only for the visions that God gives, but He doesn't grant those kinds of visions every day because they are specific to certain kinds of guidance. However, through the new birth, God has lifted you into His class of being. We're associates of the God-kind, partakers of the divine nature (2 Peter 1:4). And as God is, a creator, so are you. This means you can actually use your mind to create visions for what you want to see in your schoolwork, relationships, ministry, and future. So when you speak in tongues, one of two things should be expected: you can create a vision with your mind, your spirit-led imagination, or the Holy Spirit Himself reveals something to you.

So, if there are circumstances you desire to create or

change, whether in your church, your city, your life, or even in a nation, in your academics, character, and personal growth, speak in tongues. And through the Spirit, create the vision. Then discern by the Spirit if that vision aligns with the will of God. If it does, step into it and bring it to pass.

For example, maybe you're praying for your city because you want to see a mighty move of God and the expansion of God's Kingdom there. Or perhaps you're praying about your exams, your career path, or your future. As you pray, use your imaginative power to create the visions of your desire.

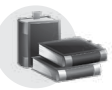

LET'S TALK



We often say that the Holy Spirit is God's greatest gift to the Church, but did you know that, in truth, the Holy Spirit is God's gift to all humanity, including young people like you? God said in Joel 2:28-29, *"And it shall come to pass afterward that I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions. And also on My menservants and on My maidservants. I will pour out My Spirit in those days."*

The Apostle Peter re-echoed the same prophecy in Acts 2:16-18 after it had come to pass. Further in the 38th and 39th verses, he said, *"...receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call"* Did you notice that? The gift of the Holy Spirit is for all, and He's been poured out upon ALL flesh, no matter your age, background, or school level.

If you haven't received Him, you should do so right away. First, be sure that you've confessed Jesus as Lord of your life. If you're yet to do so, turn to the Prayer of Salvation on page 74 of this devotional and pray the prayer, meaning it with all your heart. Then, simply declare, "I receive the Holy Spirit, and He lives in me from this day forward," and believe it with confidence.

The Holy Spirit is not a wind, a force, or a feeling; He's the very personality of the God-head at work in us. When

Jesus ascended to Heaven, He sent us the Holy Spirit to live in us, to guide, strengthen, and empower us for the divine life, including your life at school, at home, and with your friends. He's the One who makes Christianity real. Without Him, the Gospel would be mere words, but with Him, it's a living reality.

Appreciate and treasure His Person and ministry in your life above all else. Fellowship with Him in prayer, worship, and meditation on the Word, even if it's just a few minutes daily, and His wisdom will guide you, His power will sustain you, and His glory will fill your life and be evident in all that you do.

Faith is the language of the Kingdom. It's how we live, serve and please God, even as young people in our schools, homes, and communities. The Lord Jesus raised a remarkable question in our opening verse: "When the Son of man comes, shall He find faith on the earth?" Our assignment isn't only to preach salvation but also to teach the nations, our friends and classmates how to live by faith.

Faith is not a religious idea; it's a spiritual principle by which we make divine realities real in this material world, including situations like exams, friendships, and future plans. Faith calls things that are not as though they were. Faith is acting on God's Word. It's acting your believing, doing what the Word says regardless of your circumstances or feelings. When you learn to live this way, nothing would be impossible to you.

The Lord Jesus said, *"...for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there'; and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you"* (Matthew 17:20). Challenge others by your own faith, by the way you talk, study, pray, and face challenges. As you share the Gospel, let your words communicate confidence, victory and the dominion of the Word, so that others can see Jesus through your life. Help others understand that the life of faith is a life of divine

possibilities. Faith always works because it's based on the irrefutable, infallible, unchanging, all-powerful, living Word of God. Hallelujah!

TO THE BIBLE - Hebrews 3:15

“Today, if you will hear His voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion.”

LET’S TALK ►

“Have you ever felt like God was telling you to do something, but you ignored it?” Todd asked.

Laura nodded. “Yes... and later I wished I had listened.”

Todd smiled. “I’m learning that responding quickly makes a big difference.”

God speaks to us through His Word and by His Spirit, but not everyone responds rightly to His voice, especially in everyday situations like school, friendships, and choices. When you hear God’s Word, He expects a response. Your response activates His power and brings His Word to life in your situation. In the days of Samuel, God called him repeatedly, but Samuel didn’t know how to respond until Eli taught him to say, “...Speak, Lord, for Your servant hears...” (1 Samuel 3:9).

Once Samuel responded correctly, God began to talk to him. Likewise, when you respond to God in faith, His voice becomes clearer, and His presence manifests more strongly in your life, even as a young person. Never take the Word of God lightly. Each instruction, correction, or prompting of the Spirit requires a faith response, whether it’s about your studies, character, or relationships. So, to every Word from God, you say, “Yes, Lord,” and act accordingly.

Not responding to God’s Word quickly can weaken

your ability to hear from Him. But when you train your spirit to act promptly on the Word, the Spirit of God floods your heart with light, direction and grace, helping you make wise decisions daily. So always be quick to respond in faith whenever you receive God's Word, whether during your personal study, prayer, or as a prophecy. Oftentimes, His voice may sound gentle, but it carries divine power.

"Awake to righteousness...."

LET'S TALK



"I still feel bad about my past mistakes," Blessing said quietly.

Samuel replied, "But God has forgiven you. You're new in Christ now."

Blessing smiled. "So I shouldn't see myself as a failure anymore?"

Until you become conscious of your righteousness, it will not work for you. To be righteousness-conscious means to be aware that you have been justified, cleansed, and accepted before God, no matter what mistakes you made before. It means you no longer see yourself through the eyes of your past but through the righteousness of Christ.

Guilt and fear lose their power when you're righteousness-conscious. This is what Paul meant when he said, "Awake to righteousness." Wake up to who you are! You're not a sinner saved by grace; you're a new creature in Christ Jesus. Old things have passed away, and all things have become new (2 Corinthians 5:17), including your mindset and confidence.

This awareness transforms your fellowship with God and gives you the mentality of dominion in life,

even in school and among your friends. Don't say, "I'm just an ordinary person trying to please God!" No, you're not ordinary; you're the righteousness of God. Think, talk, and live righteousness, and you'll produce fruits of righteousness.

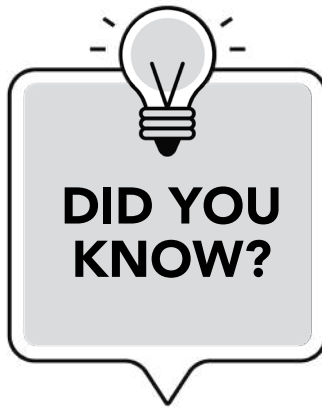

Amazing Facts About The Bamboo Tree

Bamboo is one of the most unique plants in the world, not because of how it looks, but because of how it grows. Its development follows a long, unseen process that happens entirely below the surface.

Here are seven things about bamboo that will interest you:

1. Growth starts underground.

Bamboo can spend up to five years developing an extensive root system before any shoot appears above the soil. During this time, all visible growth is delayed while underground structures strengthen.

2. It grows suddenly, but not suddenly made.

Once the root system is complete, some species of bamboo can grow up to 35 inches in a single day. This rapid growth is supported by the long period of underground development.

3. Strong roots keep it standing.

Bamboo has a fibrous rhizome root system that spreads horizontally. This structure helps anchor the plant firmly and prevents it from being easily uprooted by wind.

4. It bends without breaking.

Bamboo stalks are hollow and segmented, allowing them to flex under pressure. This flexibility reduces breakage during strong winds or heavy rainfall.

5. It grows in clusters.

Most bamboo species grow in groves connected by underground rhizomes. These connected systems allow nutrients and water to be shared across the cluster.

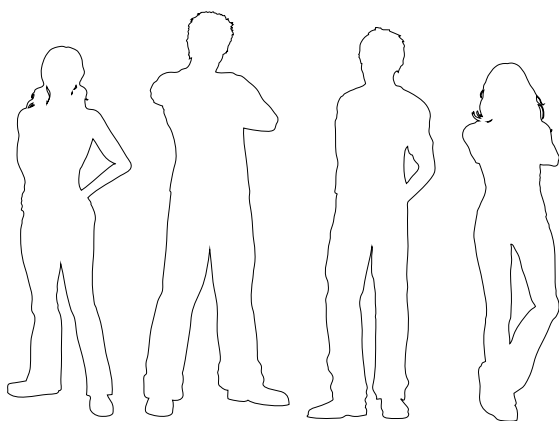
6. It's one of the strongest plants on earth.

Bamboo has a higher tensile strength than many types of steel. This makes it a reliable material for construction, scaffolding, and tools.

7. It's useful in many ways.

Bamboo is used for food, furniture, paper, textiles, and building materials. Over 1,500 known uses of bamboo exist worldwide.

Sometimes, the most important seasons of your life are the quiet ones. Like bamboo, your preparation years are not wasted. When the time is right, growth will show—and it will be undeniable.

TO THE BIBLE - Acts 1:8

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me..."

LET'S TALK

"I'm scared to talk about Jesus to my friends," Michael admitted.

Joy replied, "You're not alone. The Holy Spirit helps us."

Michael nodded. "So, He'll help me everytime I need to preach to someone?"

Absolutely! Preaching the Gospel requires the supernatural, even in school, on social media, and among friends. Notice I didn't say the "spectacular" but the supernatural. The supernatural is that which is powered by the Spirit. The Spirit of God is in us and with us; He's the power of our lives, helping us speak boldly and live right. Our sufficiency is in Him. 2 Corinthians 3:5-6 says, *"Not that we are sufficient of ourselves..."*

The ministry you've been called into is the ministry of the Spirit, even as a young soul winner and example to others. Without Him, you cannot fulfil it; but with Him, nothing is impossible. This is why your relationship with Him is absolutely vital. As much as God wanted the early disciples to go out and preach the Gospel, He gave them a profound instruction: *"And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high"* (Luke 24:49). The empowerment came just as promised in Acts 2:1-4, when they were filled with the Holy Spirit.

From that moment, everything changed; it became dynamic evangelism, just like what can happen in your life

today. They preached the Gospel with boldness and demonstrated the power of God. The message He gave us is one that's humanly difficult to believe without the supernatural, especially in today's world. How much more, therefore, do we need it in our day!

You're not the one trying to convince God to give you proof; He's the one telling you that you need it. He's the one offering it. Many pray, "O God, I want to preach the Gospel with power," but He already knows that. He's the one stirring that desire in your heart. So, pay attention as He guides you in the steps to take, even in simple daily opportunities. Having received the Holy Spirit, you now have the power to be an effective witness, wherever you are. Trust His Word. When He speaks to you and gives you guidance in your heart, receive it. His guidance is always supernatural, even when it may not appear outwardly spectacular.

JESUS: THE FULLNESS OF DEITY REVEALED

(The Divinity of Christ)

TO THE BIBLE - John 14:6-7 KJV

"Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him"

LET'S TALK

"Is Jesus really God?" This is one question many still ask today, especially among teenagers who are growing in their understanding of God and asking honest questions about their faith. They believe He was a great prophet and teacher but find it difficult to accept that He is Himself God, but He is. The Bible says *"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God"* (John 1:1). That "Word" that the Bible says "was God" became flesh – Jesus – and dwelt among us, meaning that God came close to us and lived among people like us: *"And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth"* (John 1:14).

Now, the prophecy that came forth before the birth of Jesus also foretold His divinity: "Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us." It was Jesus who walked the streets of Galilee as "Emmanuel – God with us." When people saw Him, the mighty miracles and great signs and wonders that He did, like healing the sick and helping the helpless, notice what they said: *"God has visited His people"* (Luke 7:16).

Jesus is the outward expression of the Godhead.

When we get to heaven, we won't find the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost sitting on different thrones; we'll only find one seated in the fullness of God on the throne, and His name is Jesus (Revelation 7:17).

We must recognise His Lordship and rulership over our lives, including our thoughts, online activities, friendships, studies, and future dreams. He's the joy of heaven and hope of the earth. He's the Most High, the King of kings and the Lord of lords, who alone is worthy of all praise, worship and adoration. You're identified with the most awesome and sublime personality that there is, and that gives you confidence, purpose, and a strong sense of identity.

LET'S TALK



"Are you coming to church tomorrow?" Daniel asked Ben as he cleaned his football boots.

"I'm not sure," Ben replied. "We have football practice, and my coach says attendance is compulsory."

Daniel paused. "But what about the service?"

Ben sighed. "I know... I just don't want to miss out on the team selection."

Daniel smiled gently. "Don't forget; God should always come first."

Many teenagers today miss church because of football practice, online games, social media, movies, or hanging out with friends. A young man once told me he couldn't make time to go to church on Sunday because he had to play soccer. How sad.

The Lord Jesus Christ, in the opening scripture, warns us of the need to be careful lest our hearts become overcharged with surfeiting. In other words, He's telling us to avoid overindulgence in the things we're interested in or like to do, so much so that we get lost in them. This includes spending too much time on phones, games, entertainment, and social media.

1 John 2:15-17 says, *"Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world. And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever."*

Sports, school activities, clubs, and hobbies are good, but they must never replace your walk with God. Therefore, you shouldn't let such engagements take pre-eminence over being in Church when you ought to. If you give your wholehearted attention to such transient endeavours, you'll miss out on the most significant things of life: *"For bodily exercise profits a little, but godliness is profitable for all things, having promise of the life that now is and of that which is to come"* (1 Timothy 4:8). So, to miss church services for soccer, gaming competitions, extra lessons, or even a business meeting isn't the best for you.

Even if you were ordered to go for such a business meeting or soccer practice on a Sunday morning, show yourself to be different and request a change in the schedule! Be bold enough to stand for your faith, even when it feels uncomfortable. Show yourself to be spiritual. Don't let the things of the Spirit be relegated to second place in your life.

LET'S TALK



"Josh, do you ever feel like God is far away?" David asked as they walked home from school.

Josh shook his head. "Not really. When I pray and read my Bible, it feels like I'm talking to my closest friend."

David smiled. "So... it's more than church on Sundays. It's real connection."

"Exactly," Josh replied. "That's what fellowship is about."

And that's what today's opening scripture communicates: *"That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ"* (1 John 1:3). We've been brought into a oneness of spirit—an inseparable union with divinity. This means we're spiritually connected to God, not as strangers, but as His own children. We've been called into fellowship—partnership and togetherness with Deity; it's the fellowship of the God-kind.

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To have real fellowship with God, you've got to be in His class of being. In simple terms, this means living with the awareness that you carry God's life inside you. This is the reason the Spirit of God, through the Apostle Paul, prayed that the believer might be filled with all the fullness of God; it's because

of the need for the fellowship of the God kind. He brought us into fellowship with Himself and with His Son Jesus.

As you grow in your walk with God through prayer, the Word, and obedience, this fellowship becomes stronger. It's not enough to be born of God; you can have a child, a son or a daughter, who is two years old. You can play with that child, but you can't have real fellowship with the child.

Real fellowship entails the rubbing of minds—sharing, talking at higher levels – where you can understand each other and exchange thoughts. It's like having deep conversations with a close friend who truly understands you. This is the kind of fellowship God has called us into; it's beyond making requests of Him in prayer.

This kind of fellowship is not a one-way communication. Rather, it's when God opens your mind to the realms of the spirit for you to understand things at His level. He gives you ideas, direction, and peace in your heart. It's when you see from the mountain top and communicate from the glory-realm.

Prayer, usually, is the response to the impression of the Spirit in our hearts. Sometimes, it's when God reminds you about a friend, a classmate, or a family member who needs help. It can also be a response to the impression the circumstances of other people make upon our hearts, which makes us decide we want to cause a change. I remember the testimony of a young girl who was severely physically disabled and bedridden due to juvenile arthritis. She could only move around in a wheelchair, and the only part of her body she could move was her neck, as the disease had stiffened her whole body.

She was taken to a miracle service, and while in that meeting, she wept and called on the Lord to help her. Some others saw her and began to pray for her too. As they interceded for her, she told the lady beside her she wanted to get up. Though her hands and legs felt heavy and painful, she managed to stand up. As others prayed for her, the lady encouraged her and said, "Don't worry, go ahead and move your hands and legs. The Lord has healed you."

Although it was difficult for her to move, she was encouraged by the faith of everyone present and took her first step. They all erupted in thanks and praise to the Lord as

she took another step, and then another one, and right before their eyes she began to run around the room! That happened just because those Christians around her were moved to pray for her. They weren't moved by pity but by compassion.

There's so much we can do and change in the lives of others if we'd only intercede for them. Your prayers can change what seems impossible in the lives of your friends and family. The Bible says of the Lord Jesus that He is touched with the feeling of our infirmities (Hebrews 4:15). Let the plight of the poor, the sick and the downtrodden move you to intercede for them and cause a change in their lives.

LET'S TALK



You need to know that there's an ability working in you, and that ability is supernatural! It doesn't burn out, and it doesn't need replenishing. That means that your physical ability should no longer hold you back or dictate just how much you can do. Even when you feel tired, overwhelmed with school, assignments, exams, or pressure from friends, that ability is still active in you.

Haven't you read how Samson defeated one thousand trained soldiers of war with the jawbone of an ass? He could never have done it with his physical ability, no matter how good a fighter he was. The Spirit of God came on him mightily, and he was divinely enabled; he was energised to do superhuman things.

For us, it's even better, because the supplier of that divine energy, the Holy Ghost, lives in us. That means our potentials are limitless! We've been energised for the supernatural. Paul knew this for sure; that's why he wrote the words in our opening scripture for us. He calls it "Christ's mighty energy"; the King James Version calls it *"his working, which worketh in me mightily."* Glory to God! God's supernatural ability works in you mightily, helping you achieve results that are beyond your age and physical ability.

The Bible says, *"Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God"* (2 Corinthians 3:5). The word translated "sufficiency" also means "ability." This means there's a divine ability available to you, and that ability is the power of the Holy Ghost at work in you. If you'd take advantage of this divine ability, it'll make a difference at school and in whatever you do. You'll go further, faster and better than your physical ability can take you.

GROWING AND MULTIPLYING IN GRACE

TO THE BIBLE - Ephesians 4:7 NIV

LET'S TALK



Wearing a school uniform doesn't make you the best student. Studying, learning, and growing give you the ability to excel. The uniform identifies you. The skills empower you. That's how the anointing and grace work. There's a vital distinction between grace and the anointing. Many use both terms interchangeably, yet the Word of God shows they're not the same. The anointing refers to the consecration and indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit, the empowerment that sets you apart for God's purpose.

Grace, on the other hand, refers to the divine enablement and favour granted you according to your specific calling and responsibility in the body of Christ. Every Christian has received the same anointing, for it's the same Holy Spirit that dwells in us all. That anointing abides in you, never diminishes, and brings special grace into your life: "But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift" (Ephesians 4:7). However, grace operates differently. You can grow in grace (2 Peter 3:18), the grace on your life can be multiplied (2 Peter 1:2), and you can receive more grace, as the Bible says, "...He gives more grace..." (James 4:6). Yes, He gives more grace, but He doesn't give more

anointing.

You can grow in grace as you grow in faith, in the knowledge of God, and the revelation of the Lord Jesus Christ. Grace determines your scope of influence and effectiveness in the calling God has given you. Recognize, therefore, that while your grace can increase, your anointing is complete. You already have the fullness of the Spirit. Live with this understanding and allow the grace of God in your life to multiply through your knowledge of God and fellowship with the Word. Hallelujah!

This life makes you superior to Satan, sickness, disease, failure, and death.

The Lord Jesus didn't come to give us religion; He came to give us the God-life (John 10:10). In John 10:27-28, He said, *"My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish...."* It makes you indestructible and invincible. It means your life is not controlled by fear, peer pressure, failure, or negative opinions. It makes you a partaker of the divine nature. As one who's born again and has received the God-life, you're one hundred per cent divine in your spirit, even while living in a human body and going to school every day. You're a hundred per cent divine despite having a human body.

Another beautiful truth is that you're a distributor of that life—the God-life in you. God's life in you is meant to affect your classmates, friends, and family. Anything and anyone you touch comes alive because you're born in the image and similitude of the life giver, the Lord Jesus Christ,

the second and last Adam (read 1 Corinthians 15:45–47 ESV). As He is, so are you in this world (1 John 4:17).

You're a life-giver, a minister of life. Wherever you go, you bring healing, peace, and transformation. When you lay your hands on the sick, the life in you flows out of you to bring restoration. When you speak words of faith, life is transmitted into every situation. You're not meant to blend in with negativity, gossip, or hopelessness. You're of a higher class, a divine species, chosen and separated by God to manifest His life, glory, and righteousness in the earth. Hallelujah!

Philippians 1:11 talks about the fruits of righteousness: *"Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God."* When the righteousness of God was imparted to your spirit, it came with the capacity to produce fruits consistent with God's nature in you. These fruits are visible expressions of your new life: acts of love, purity, excellence, peace, and truth. They show in how you treat your classmates, teachers, friends, and even people online.

The Holy Spirit in you causes you to walk in righteousness naturally. You don't struggle to do right; your spirit delights in the Word and produces fruits that glorify God. The world may admire and applaud men for good deeds, but true righteousness comes only from the life of God in a man. Now that you're born again, manifest Christ, His glory and His righteousness. Your conduct, speech, and attitude should always reflect His divine character and attributes because you're born of Him. This includes how

you talk in class, on social media, and at home.

Everywhere you go, bring in justice, integrity, and goodness. Let your life be replete with the fruits of righteousness. Our opening scripture says, *"Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven"* (Matthew 5:16).

God wants the world to experience the outward manifestations of the righteousness of God in you. He wants His glory demonstrated through you. He has made you a living testimony of His righteousness. So, let your life radiate His goodness, excellence, and love. Let people see Jesus in the way you speak, act, study, and relate with others. MERCY

"Through the Lord's mercies we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness" (Lamentations 3:22–23 NKJV).

The word "mercy" in the Old Testament is often translated from the Hebrew word "hesed", which means lovingkindness, steadfast love, or covenant kindness. It's a rich, active love that goes beyond feeling—it is a deliberate, covenantal compassion shown even when it is undeserved. In the New Testament, mercy is translated from the Greek word "eleos", which carries the same sense of compassionate kindness.

Mercy is not passive; it is dynamic and demonstrative. When King David asked, *"Is there yet any of the house of Saul that I may show him kindness for Jonathan's sake?"* (2 Samuel 9:1), he was not simply speaking of a polite gesture. The Hebrew word translated as "show" here implies demonstrating mercy — to actively express and bring to life kindness that changes the status of another. David sought to demonstrate mercy on Mephibosheth, Jonathan's son, restoring him to honour and provision at the king's own table.

This example reveals a deep truth: mercy is the lovingkindness of God extended to those who have no claim on it. It takes a greater person to have mercy on someone lesser. The mercy of God flows from His throne, not based on our worthiness, but on His gracious disposition to be kind.

Mercy is not earned by effort or works; it is given by the One who chooses to show compassion and favour. This mercy is active compassion—a compassion that compels God to move on our behalf. Mercy is His nature and the essence of His kingdom. As we receive mercy, we become vessels of His lovingkindness, called to extend it to others.



i-testify!

When I first read the Teevo article about "The Wisdom of His Process," it was like a light turned on in my heart. LET'S TALK



There's something profoundly beautiful about the righteousness we have in Christ Jesus: even though it was given to us as a gift, it is a gift well deserved. Someone might say, "But I thought it was an unmerited favour?" Not exactly; righteousness wasn't given to us as an unmerited favour but as a well-deserved gift of grace, and I'll explain.

First, understand that Christianity didn't begin before the Cross, on the Cross, or even from the Cross; it began after the resurrection. What does this mean? When God raised Jesus from the dead, He raised Him with the righteousness of God. And the Bible says we were raised together with Him. When the Lord Jesus was raised from the dead, He was born again. This means that when you gave your life to Christ, you didn't just join a church; you received a new life and a new identity.

Your old nature was crucified with Him. Everything about you that was condemned or condemnable was nailed to the Cross with Him. Romans 6:4 says, *"Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life."* So, when Jesus was raised from the dead, we were born into a newness of life; we were born with His righteousness. It

wasn't unmerited!

So, you're not trying to "be good enough" for God. You're already accepted in Christ. Even when you make mistakes, God doesn't reject you. We deserved what we got because we're born of Him. We belong to Him. Let this understanding guide your walk with God! This is the very message He sent us to preach and teach. He wants the world to know that they've been made righteous in Christ Jesus.

It's a gift purchased by the blood of Jesus Christ. Hallelujah! This means you can be confident in school, online, and among your friends, knowing who you are in Christ. You don't have to follow wrong pressure just to fit in. Praise God!

LET'S TALK



The righteousness of God at work in you is such a powerful thing; it causes everything in your life to align with His divine purpose and provision. This includes your studies, your talents, your future, and even the dreams in your heart. It's a righteous thing with God to do you good because that's His nature. It's consistent with His righteousness to channel every necessary resource toward you, ensuring that you lack nothing for all He's called you to do.

Ephesians 1:3 says He's blessed us with ALL spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ Jesus. There's no blessing from God that's missing in your life; you have them all! So even when you feel "not good enough" or "not ready," God has already equipped you. Also, ponder again what we read in our opening scripture: His divine power has given you everything you require for life and godliness. The word godliness there refers to your life of godliness, the things God has called you to do, your life in God.

So, think for a moment; what do you require to fulfil the godly life God has called you to? It's available. You already have it. Whether it's wisdom for exams, courage to say no to bad influence, strength to stay focused, or

confidence to be yourself, God has supplied it. Satan may suggest otherwise, but he's a liar and not a factor. Instead, declare, "I walk by faith in God's Word. I have what God says I have. The Lord is my Shepherd; I refuse to lack. All things are mine."

2 Corinthians 9:8 AMPC says, *"...God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation]."* And He's done it! Blessed be God!

HOW TO KNOW THE VOICE OF THE SPIRIT

TO THE BIBLE - John 10:27

"My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me"

LET'S TALK



One question many Christians have asked is: "How do I know when the Holy Spirit is talking to me?" The first and most important thing is to receive the Holy Spirit into your heart. When you do, He doesn't just visit. He lives in you and becomes your constant guide.

The Bible says, *"He who is joined to the Lord is one spirit"* (1 Corinthians 6:17), so you and the Holy Spirit are connected. Soon, you'll notice His voice talking to you from your spirit. Romans 8:16 says the Spirit *"bears witness with our spirit,"* so your own spirit confirms that it's Him speaking. He is the best Teacher, so first you receive Him, and then He will guide you to recognize His voice.

Another important thing to do in knowing the voice of the Spirit is to get really familiar with the Bible, because His words always line up with Scripture. He won't tell you to do something that goes against God's Word. John 16:13 says, *"However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come."* If you know the Word well, you'll notice whenever the Holy Spirit talks to you, because His voice always agrees with Scripture. His voice and the Bible

always match.

The Holy Spirit is the Master Communicator and knows the best way to grab your attention. The Bible gives the example of Moses and the burning bush. The bush was on fire, but it didn't burn up. God just needed Moses to notice it. When Moses moved closer, God spoke—but only after He got Moses' attention. After that, Moses didn't need another burning bush to know God's voice. The same is true for you: He can speak while you're doing homework, texting a friend, or deciding what to do in a tough situation. He will teach you to hear Him clearly.

King Nebuchadnezzar once had a dream that stressed him out big time. He called all his wise men together. "Tell me the dream AND the meaning, or you're dead!" he yelled. The wise men froze—they had no idea what the king dreamed. They told him: *"...There is not a man on earth who can show the king's matter: ...there is no king, lord, nor ruler, who asked such things of any magician, astrologer, or Chaldean. And it is a rare thing that the king requires, and there is none other who can show it before the king, except the gods, whose dwelling is not with flesh"* (Daniel 2:10–11).

The king got furious and ordered all the wise men, including Daniel and his friends, to be executed (Daniel 2:12–13). But Daniel stepped forward and asked for some time. He and his friends prayed that night. God revealed the dream and its meaning to Daniel, who in turn revealed it to the king. Nebuchadnezzar had to agree and proclaim that indeed Daniel had an excellent spirit.

With the Holy Spirit, you won't have to feel lost about school choices, friendships, plans, or big decisions. The

Bible says: *"The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but the things revealed belong to us and our children forever..."* (Deuteronomy 29:29). Think about it: The Holy Spirit can guide your thoughts, inspire your actions, and help you make choices that match God's plan. Glory to God!

CHRIST IS A PLACE

(What “In Christ” Really Means for Your Life)

TO THE BIBLE - 2 Corinthians 5:17

“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.”

LET’S TALK

“Do you think God is building us mansions in heaven?” Jake asked.

“I used to,” Daniel replied. “But it’s actually something better.”

“Better than a mansion?!” Jake’s eyes widened. “How?”

Well, let’s see what the Lord Jesus really meant. In John 14:2–3 Jesus said, *“In My Father’s house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.”* Many misinterpret this portion of Scripture to mean that when someone gives his life to Christ, God starts building a mansion for him (or her) in heaven. This sounds exciting, but that’s not what Jesus meant. In the verse above, Jesus wasn’t talking about heaven; He was referring to our place in Christ.

So, not only is Christ a Person, but He’s also a place. That’s what the Apostle Paul alludes to in our opening scripture. We are in Christ. We’ve been made to sit together with Him in heavenly places (Ephesians 2:6), which means the place Jesus prepared is not somewhere far away in the future, but where we already are in Him today. You came into Christ when you were born again; it’s a heavenly realm called Zion, the city of the living God. That’s the city of our habitation: *“But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly*

Jerusalem, to an innumerable company of angels” (Hebrews 12:22).

In Christ, there’s no sin, sickness, disease, failure, poverty, defeat, weakness, or death; all you have is health, joy, peace, success, strength, prosperity, beauty, and life forevermore! This means your life is not meant to be ruled by fear, insecurity, or confusion. That’s your place of inheritance; it’s the place of divine authority and power, where you reign and rule over satan and the cohorts of darkness.

So, even as a teenager, you’re not weak or ordinary. You’re powerful in Christ. So, when you say, “I’m in Christ,” you ought to understand the import of that statement, for it means that’s where you live; your address is Christ! It affects how you think, talk, choose friends, and make decisions. Therefore, view the world from there.

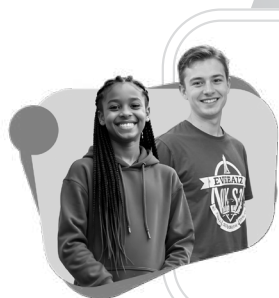

TO THE BIBLE - 1 John 5:11-12

"And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life"

LET'S TALK



Society may place limits on you; your background, where you're from, your school, your grades, your family situation, or your finances could place limits on you. But there's a life without limits; that's the life Jesus brought to us; it's the transcendent life of glory where there are no limitations—A life unlimited by sickness, disease, failure, the devil, fear, discouragement, or low self-esteem!

Jesus proved it was possible to live this triumphant life when He walked the earth. He lived a life that was greater than anything that existed on the terrestrial plane. He refused to be limited by the circumstances of this world. He tamed nature. The Bible tells us how He defied the laws of nature by walking on water *"in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went to them, walking on the sea"* (Matthew 14:25), and hushing the sea to sleep *"Then He arose and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, 'Peace, be still!' And the wind ceased and there was a great calm"* (Mark 4:39).

Satan, death, nor the grave could limit Him. When He died, the Bible says through that death, He paralyzed him that has the power of death, that is, the devil *"that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil"* (Hebrews 2:14). Thereafter, He rose triumphantly

from the grave. This is the life to which you've been called, where nothing can hinder or place limits on you. According to our opening scripture, you received this life when you were born again.

The Bible tells several inspiring stories of people who had faith for others to be healed. Even when they couldn't bring their loved ones to Jesus physically, they got a miracle. This means that you can have faith for someone to receive their miracle.

A certain Centurion, whose dear servant was sick and ready to die, is one of such. When he heard of Jesus, he sent the elders of the Jews to beseech Him that He would come and heal his servant. Jesus agreed and followed them. But just before they got to the Centurion's house, the Centurion sent a message to Jesus and said, *"Lord, do not trouble Yourself, for I am not worthy that You should enter under my roof; therefore I did not even think myself worthy to come to You. But say the word, and my servant will be healed"* (Luke 7:2-7).

When Jesus heard the words of the Centurion, He marvelled at his faith and turned to those that followed Him and said, *"I have not found such great faith, not even in*

Israel!" By the time the messengers got back to the Centurion's house, they found the hitherto sick servant perfectly healed and made whole (Luke 7:9–10). The faith of his master prevailed, and he (the servant) got a miracle!

So, the question is: What do you want? The Centurion was very clear about what he wanted for his servant, and he was convinced that the Master's words were powerful enough to give him a miracle. The same applies to you today! Stand in the gap for others who are weak and helpless by asking the Father, in the Name of Jesus, for a miracle on their behalf, and believe with confidence that God hears you and responds.

LET'S TALK



Years ago, just right after I said to someone once, "Trust is not just given to you; you earn it," the Spirit of God interrupted me and said, "No, son, you're wrong. You don't earn trust; trust is a gift." I was surprised because, before that time, I thought trust was earned. But here was God saying no man could earn trust. The Lord then guided me through the Scriptures, and I saw things I didn't realize and came to the conclusion that trust was indeed a gift as He had taught me.

No man in himself deserves to be trusted, no matter how trustworthy he seems, not even your closest friends. If you're honest with yourself, you'll discover that even you are not totally trustworthy. For example, there may have been times when you promised to pray for someone, help with homework, or show up for a friend, and you didn't. What if that one's life, for whom you were to pray, depended solely on your prayers at that time? But God, nevertheless, has chosen to trust you with the Gospel (2 Corinthians 5:18).

This is something that friends, classmates, teammates, co-workers, and spouses need to learn. In school, at home, and online, people don't always "qualify" for your trust. You trust them because you love them and you expect the best

of them. The man who can trust another is greater than the one he trusts, because trust helps him gain a level of faith to make provisions for the errors of others.

Those who can't trust others are men of small minds. When you begin to see life the way God sees it, you'll stop judging people only by their mistakes; you'll start learning to trust people and not rate them according to who they are and what they do (2 Corinthians 5:16), but according to your expectation of them. Learning to trust doesn't mean being careless; it means choosing love, forgiveness, and faith over fear.

Ever heard the saying, "Life is not a bed of roses"? Well, not the Christian life! It is, indeed, a bed of roses. Why else would the Psalmist say, *"Because the Lord is my Shepherd, I have everything I need! He lets me rest in the meadow grass and leads me beside the quiet streams..."* (Psalms 23:1-2 TLB). However, it's a bed of roses that comes with tests and trials. Such challenging times are what our opening verse refers to as "the day of adversity." Some believers dread such times and fervently pray to God to never to allow them go through them. However, to avoid situations that challenge your faith is to limit your spiritual growth and reduce your chances of promotion.

James 1:2 says, *"My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials."* Why would God admonish you to rejoice when tests and challenges come at you on all sides? It's because He knows that victory is in your spirit. Having been born again, you've become an overcomer and more than a conqueror. Consequently, no situation that you face should overwhelm you.

There are things that make you tough as a Christian, and if you don't welcome them, you'd remain at the same level of faith and maturity. Therefore, your adversaries are important in the toughening process, so never pray

against them, no matter what troubles, problems and difficulties they bring your way. See challenges as spiritual training that builds your strength and confidence in God. Welcome them to strengthen your faith-muscles, and you'll discover they're the agents for your promotion.

I have known only one journey in life: upward and forward. I don't have ups and downs. That doesn't mean challenges don't come, but I always win. No matter what you face in school, at home, or with friends, refuse to quit. So welcome challenges; welcome troubles because they're the contrary winds that help to drive your roots deeper. And the more the wind blows against you, the higher you'll fly. Hallelujah!

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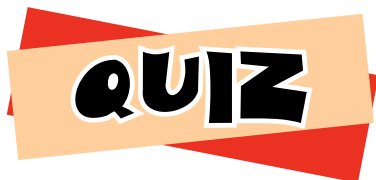
